

section A – INdigital ESiNet overview


1. Our work continues to connect and test all services that use the ESiNet. The detail of the network status is shown at right, and the current ethernet services map is on the next page.




2. This map shows the status of the ethernet connectivity that is the INdigital G-15 ESiNet.








